- Orderers: Kvarken Council (lead part), Blå vägen and MidtSkandia
 - Regional Council of Ostrobothnia, Region Västerbotten and Nordland Fylkeskommune
 - + 14 other partners and financiers
- 2.5M EUR in 2½ years
 - Finland + Sweden 2,197,500 EUR
 - Norway 381,691 EUR
 - Investigation and cooperation funds
- E12 Atlantica BA3NET, sister project
 - Cerum/University of Umeå, University of Vaasa and Nord University



Purpose and targets

- To continue the development of the transport corridor along the E12 from Helgeland to Ostrobothnia and to reduce the border barriers
- To strengthen cooperation between the ordering organizations and the partners
- The project shall:
 - strengthen the corridor's attractiveness and competitiveness
 - create a foundation for future infrastructure investments
 - strengthen cooperation with trade and industry
 - compile high-quality materials for decision-making



Work packages

- **Functional transport route**
 - System analysis for the entire route
 - Case studies and pilots
 - Port and terminal group
- **Cross-border strategies**
 - Joint infrastructure planning and traffic strategy
 - Stronger position at national level
- **Future cooperation structures**
 - Joint cooperation structure in the future
 - Annual Nordic forum for public and private actors in infrastructure development
