*From Idea to Itinerary – Bothnian
Coastal Route becomes a Nordic cross-
border destination*



The Bothnian Coastal Route project reached its finale in Oulu on 26 November, where partners, companies and international travel trade representatives gathered to review three years of cross-border collaboration between Finland and Sweden. The day highlighted both the achievements and the growing potential of the region as a joint Nordic destination.

When Project Manager **Marianne Sjöström** looked back at the Bothnian Coastal Route journey in Oulu, she described standing there with “mixed feelings” – proud of what had been built, but also a little melancholic that the project period is now coming to an end. Four and a half years earlier, partners around the Bothnian Bay coast in Finland and Sweden started drafting a bold application to the new Interreg Aurora programme. The goal was ambitious: to create awareness of the Bothnian Coastal Route as an attractive travel route for visitors and locals and provide a sound basis for growth and sustainable tourism.

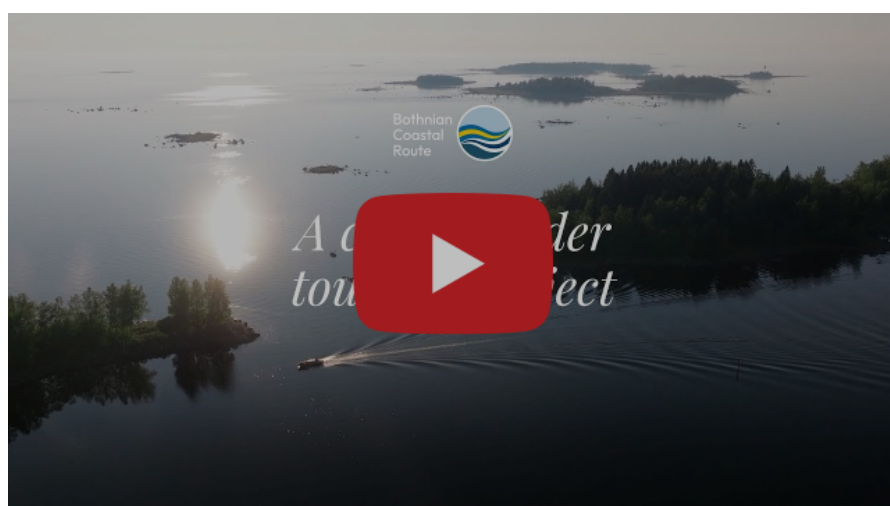


“More than roofs and walls” – companies on what the Bothnian Coastal Route has changed

Project duration: 1.1.2023-31.12.2025

Budget: 2 712 677 euros

The total budget of this project is 2 712 677,00 EUR, whereof 1 763 241,00 EUR EU-funding via the Interreg Aurora programme.

The rest of the funding comes from Finnish national and Swedish regional co-funding, from the Nordic Council of Ministers, and from municipal and private co-funding.

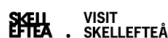

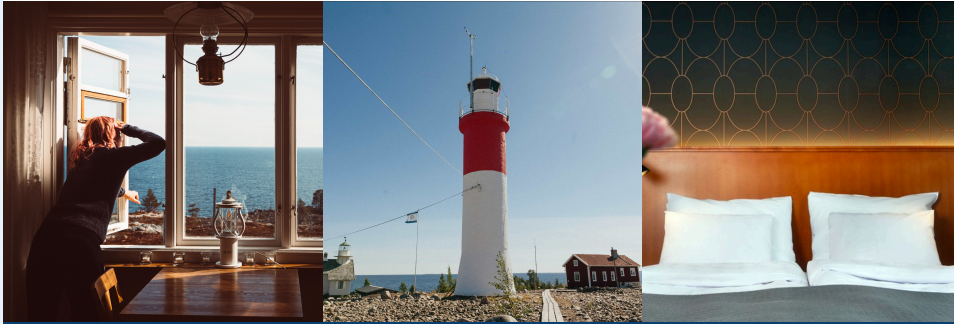
